IRISH RED CROSS SOCIETY ORDER, 1939 (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1957.

The Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1 of the Red Cross Act, 1938 (No. 32 of 1938), hereby order as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Irish Red Cross Society Order, 1939 (Amendment) Order, 1957.
- 2. The Second Schedule to the Irish Red Cross Society Order, 1939 (S.R. & O., No. 206 of 1939), is hereby smended by the substitution, for paragraph 1, of the following paragraph:
 - "1. The quorum for a meeting of the Executive Committee shall be five."

The effect of the instrument is that the quorum for a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Central Council of the Irish Red Cross Society is increased from three to five. The increase is considered desirable because of the important functions which the Executive Committee is required to exercise on behalf of the Society.
