We have the honour to submit our Annual Report for the year ended 31st December, 1991.

While the licensing and prohibition provisions of the Video Recordings Act, 1989 came into operation in 1991 the need to perform functions in relation to the censorship of video recordings did not arise during the year. However, we continued to perform our functions under the Censorship of Films Acts, 1923 to 1970 and details of the appeals dealt with during the year are as follows:

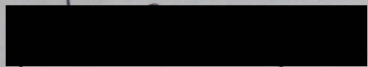

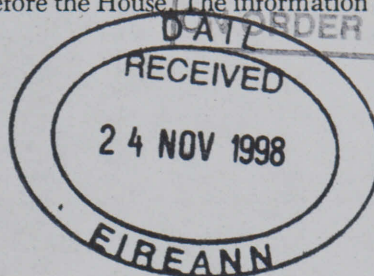
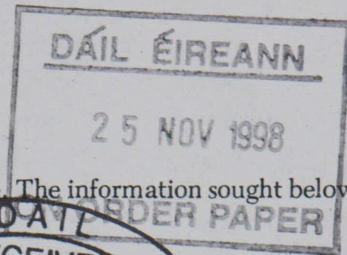
