
FIFTH REPORT OF THE CENSORSHIP

TO: MS. NORA OWEN, T.D.
MINISTER FOR JUSTICE

We have the honour to submit our Annual Report for the year ended December 31 1994.

While the licensing and prohibition provisions of the Video Recordings Act, 1989 came into operation in 1991 the need to perform functions in relation to the censorship of video recordings did not arise during the year. However, we continued to perform our functions under the Censorship of Films Act, 1923 to 1992 and details of the appeals dealt with during the year are as follows:-

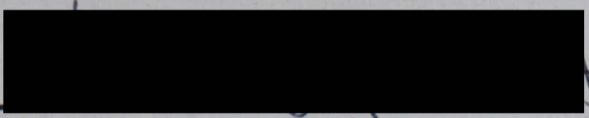

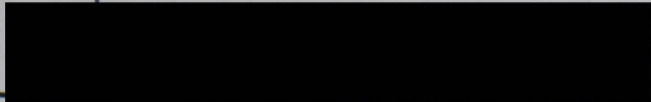
